

The Wage Assessment (#6647) in this matter directed the employer, Gas Plus (Sask-Man) Inc., or Craig Kury, or Sal Handel, both being directors of Gas Plus (Sask-Man) Inc., to pay Daniel Missouri the amount of \$2,869.55. The wage Assessment was based on the Director of Employment Standards' finding that the employer had made deductions from Daniel Missouri's wages, and that the deductions were not permitted under *The Saskatchewan Employment Act*. The employer appealed.

At the hearing, Mr. Stretch, an Employment Standards Officer, informed me that the parties had come to an agreement whereby the employer Gas Plus (Sask-Man) Inc., would agree to pay, and Daniel Missouri would agree to accept, the amount of \$359.56 as a full settlement of the Wage Assessment (#6647) amount of \$2,869.55. Two releases were filed with me. In the first release (marked Exhibit 1) dated Sept. 18, 2014, Craig Kury as a director of Gas Plus (Sask-Man) Inc. agrees that \$359.56 shall be paid out to Daniel Missouri as final settlement of this complaint. In the second release (marked Exhibit 2) dated Sept. 19, 2014 Daniel Missouri agrees to settle this complaint for the amount of \$359.56. Craig Kury, Daniel Missouri and Gas Plus (Sask-Man) Inc., each agree not to commence any litigation or other proceedings against the others, pertaining to Daniel Missouri's employment with Gas Plus (Sask-Man) Inc.

Decision: With the consent of the parties I order that wage Assessment #6647 be varied by being lowered to \$359.56.
