## Pursuant to Sections 2-75 and 4-6 of The Saskatchewan Employment Act

On April 8, 2024, I was appointed adjudicator for an appeal filed by BLT Enterprises respecting Wage Assessment 1-000724.

To determine compliance with sections 2-74 and 2-75 of the Act, on April 9, 2024, I requested the Ministry to provide all relevant documents respecting this appeal. That same day I received the requested documents.

Canada Post documents show the Wage Assessment was registered on December 6, 2023, and was accepted by BLT Director Brent Lang on December 7, 2023. BLT appeal document dated December 5, 2023, and signed by Brent Lang was received by the Ministry and date stamped January 3, 2024.

The Ministry has no record of receipt of a \$500.00 deposit.

On April 10, 2024, I e-mailed Mr. Lang, indicating there is no record of a deposit being made by BLT. His response was it was during the holiday season and must have been missed.

Section 2-75 of the Act stipulates that an appeal must be received by the Director of Labour Standards with-in 15 business day of receipt of the wage assessment document. Further a deposit of \$500.00 must reach the Director with-in that 15 day period.

Since BLT Enterprises failed to comply with section 2-75 of the Act, I do not have jurisdiction to hear the appeal.

The Wage Assessment is upheld, and BLT Enterprises Ltd are directed to pay Kyle Beck the amount of \$1053.90.
